## TROUBLESHOOTING FOR MARK 3

## SYSTEM WILL NOT BOOT:

- 1. Is power LED lit? No, check backplane voltages.
- 2. Does system respond with OK at master terminal? No, press RESET, then T to run self-test. If it will not run, replace CPU board.
- 3. If PRESS RETURN does not show on display, press P. If system does not boot shortly, press RESET.
- Read memory contents by entering DØ. If contents are same as address, write to memory to test it.
- 5. Enter K0,400,0.
- 6. Enter D0. Memory locations 0-400 should be all 0's.
- 7. Enter KØ, 400, 177777.
- 8. Enter D0. Memory locations 0-400 should be 177777. If not, there is a memory problem.
- 9. Power off/on the system. If it still doesn't IPL, check for disk problems, bad OS, etc. Attempt to boot from tape.
