LP-370 Controller is Now Field-Configurable for DAVFU

The LP-370 Line Printer Controller can now be field-configured for Data Products brand printers with or without the DAVFU (Direct Access Vertical Format Unit) option.

This applies to LP-370 units shipped after October 17, 1984. Complete instructions for the jumper setting are in the LP-370 Technical Manual, Section 3.2.10.

DAVFU is the forms control option on the printer supported only under AOS or AOS/VS. (The Centronics forms control option does not work with DG software and must be disabled. Printers by other manufacturers are not affected by this -- set the LP-370 as non-DAVFU to accomodate them.)

Since factory configuration is still recommended for non-technical customers, please indicate DAVFU yes or no in the space provided on the LP-370 Configuration Form.
